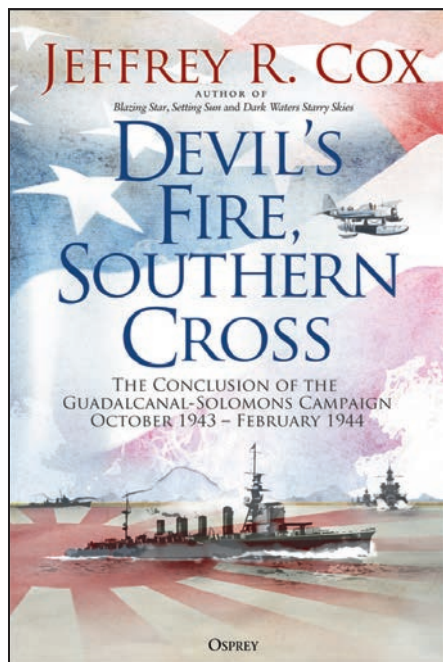

The Conclusion of the Guadalcanal-Solomons Campaign, October 1943–February 1944

Jeffrey R. Cox

A fast-paced and absorbing read of the final months of the crucial Guadalcanal-Solomons Campaign during the Pacific War.

This page-turning history examines the closing months of this vital campaign which determined the eventual successful conclusion of the Pacific War for the Allies. But it had not been a smooth process. The campaign continued in fits and starts with both the US Navy and the Imperial Japanese Navy making crucial errors.

At the start of the Guadalcanal-Solomons Campaign the US Navy was the underdog. By its conclusion, US naval commanders had come of age. Combining first-rate scholarly research with a novelist's flair for the dramatic, Jeffrey R. Cox concludes his brilliant quartet on this crucial campaign.

Jeffrey R. Cox is a litigation attorney and an independent military historian. A student of history, international affairs and defense policy for most of his life, his first book was the critically acclaimed *Rising Star, Falling Skies* (2014) about the Java Sea Campaign. This was followed by three successful volumes on the Guadalcanal-Solomons Campaign: *Morning Star, Midnight Sun* (2018), *Blazing Star, Setting Sun* (2020) and *Dark Waters, Starry Skies* (2022). He resides in Indianapolis.

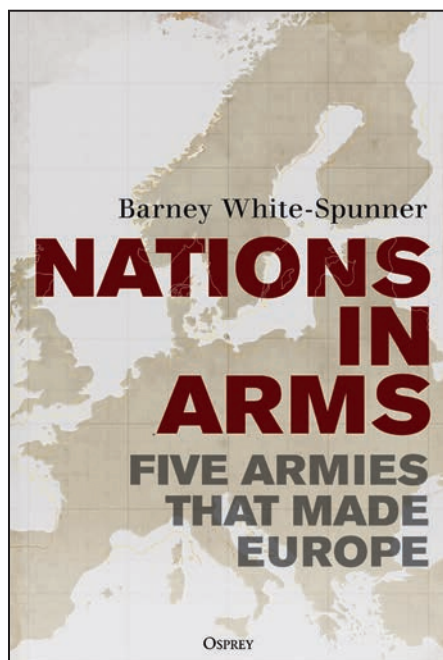

Nations in Arms

The Five Armies That Made Europe

Barney White-Spunner

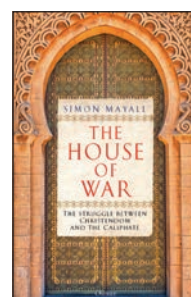
A critical study of five historical armies that offers solutions for how contemporary forces need to change to deal with modern threats.

The most important task of any government remains the defence of its state and its citizens. Traditionally governments have used armed forces to do this. World events and comparative peace in Europe since 1989 have led most European governments to lose their focus on defence. However, recent events have proved that war is now as nasty, violent, destructive and prevalent as it has ever been, and governments need to fundamentally re-think their relationship with armies and soldiers.

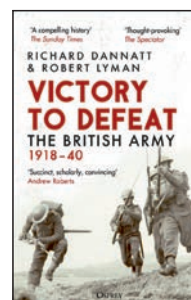
History gives us several examples of states which have reconstructed their armies successfully, both on the field of battle but also in terms of how they relate to the state which it is their duty to protect. This book is about five armies who have adapted successfully: the 4th-century Roman army of Constantine the Great; the 15th-century Ottoman army of Sultan Mehmet II; Cromwell's New Model Army of the English Civil War; the Prussian Army of the Napoleonic Wars; and the US Army of the Second World War.

Barney White-Spunner commanded British and allied troops on operations at every level from troop to division, was policy director in the Ministry of Defence, commanded on operations within the US Army, restructured the British Army for Afghanistan and commanded the British Field Army. As a military historian he has written *Horse Guards* (2006), *Of Living Valour* (2015), *Partition* (2017) and *Berlin* (2021). He has also served as the President of the Society for Army Historical Research.

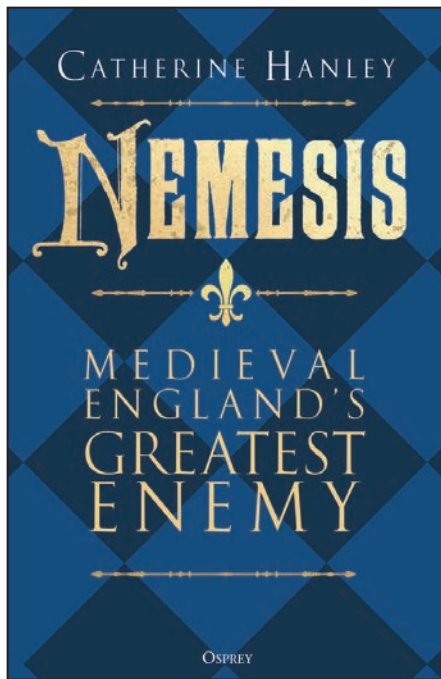

Philip II ruled France with an iron fist for over 40 years, expanding its borders and increasing its power. And yet we know so little about medieval England's greatest enemy.

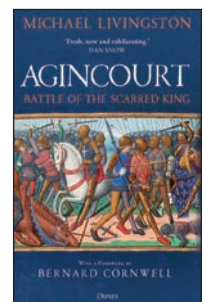

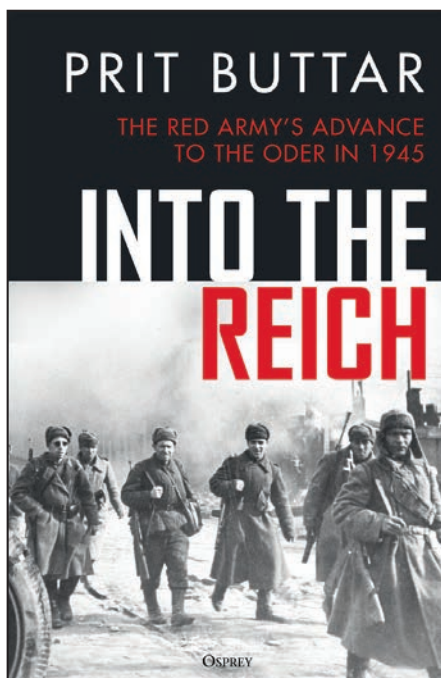

Into the Reich

The Red Army's advance to the Oder in 1945

Prit Buttar

Enriched by extraordinary first-hand accounts, this is a fascinating history of the dying days of the Third Reich as Stalin sought to consolidate his own empire.

In January 1945, the Red Army launched a powerful offensive across the Vistula River to drive the Wehrmacht out of Poland, with the intention of securing a start line for an operation that would ultimately result in the capture of Berlin and the end of the war. But, as Prit Buttar expertly reveals, there were other issues at play. Stalin was determined to push the boundaries of the Soviet Union further west, restoring land lost by the tsars and securing vast industrial and mineral wealth. While negotiations took place between the Allied powers regarding the fate of Poland, the Red Army burst through the German lines, liberating Auschwitz even as the SS drove concentration camp inmates onto frozen roads in a series of death marches.

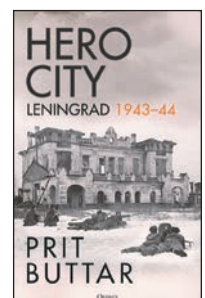
The Wehrmacht staged a desperate fight back with their last major armoured offensive on the Eastern Front. Written by an acknowledged expert on the subject and packed with first-hand accounts, this is the definitive account of the strategic goals, both military and political, of Stalin, his generals, and their armies as they raced into the Reich, and of the German forces who stood in the way.

Prit Buttar is a retired doctor who has written extensively on the Eastern Front in both world wars. His books have been translated into Polish, Lithuanian, Estonian, Finnish, Italian, Hungarian, and Chinese. An established expert on the Eastern Front in 20th-century military history, his most recent titles include a critically acclaimed two-volume series on the siege of Leningrad.

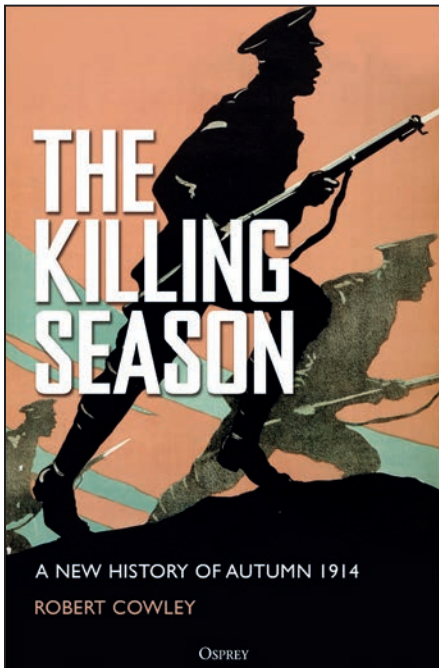

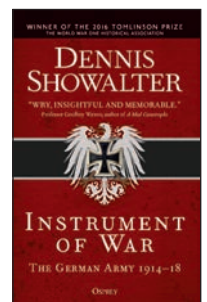
In a re-examination of events that have too long seemed set in stone, Cowley combines a wide array of source materials with sharp portrayals both of military leaders and the men they lead.

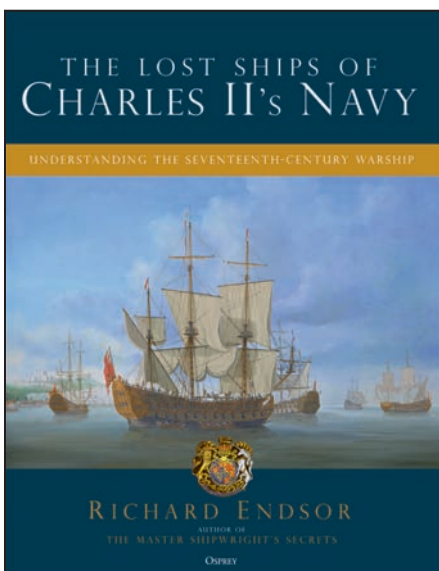

The Lost Ships of Charles II's Navy

Understanding the Seventeenth-Century Warship

Richard Endors

A comprehensively researched and beautifully illustrated history of the design of the ships of Charles II's Navy, using reconstructed architectural plans based on contemporary records.

The Royal Navy of the late seventeenth century was the greatest enterprise in the country, and in 1677, with Samuel Pepys as Secretary of the Navy, the House of Commons voted to fund the building of 30 new ships, the largest single shipbuilding project up to this point. This new history by award-winning naval historian Richard Endors describes the history of this great endeavour, and seeks to recreate architectural plans of these ships based on detailed measurements and calculations left behind by Edmund Dummer, an assistant to master shipwright Sir Anthony Deane and later Surveyor of the Navy from 1692 to 1699.

Using Dummer's surviving notebook, supported by the official specification dimension list for the ships, large-scale, artistic drawings and several surviving models, *The Lost Ships of Charles II's Navy* contains dimensioned and accurate architectural plans for several named ships alongside numerous other illustrations, including contemporary Van de Velde drawings of the ships.

Richard Endors has written extensively on the structures and the building process of seventeenth-century ships, including *The Restoration Warship* (2009), *The Warship Anne* (2017) and most recently, *The Master Shipwright's Secrets* (2020) for which he was awarded the prestigious Anderson Medal for the best maritime book published in 2020.

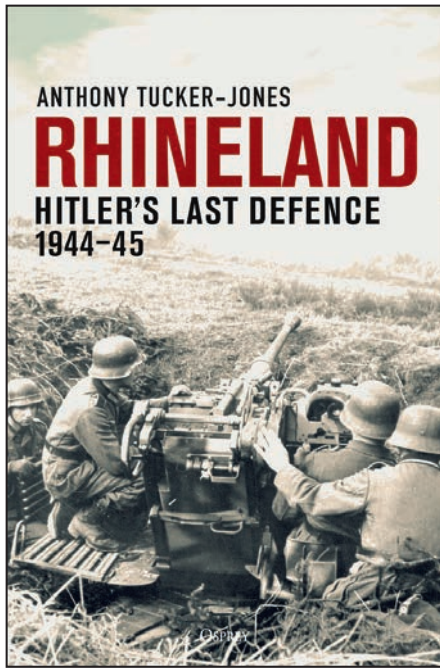

Rhineland

Hitler's Last Defence, 1944-45

Anthony Tucker-Jones

A dramatic retelling of the desperate battle of the Rhineland during World War II from the German perspective.

The Rhineland was where Adolf Hitler sowed the seeds for the Second World War when he remilitarized it in breach of the Treaty of Versailles in 1936, and by late 1944 the Rhine provided the last major obstacle to the advancing Allied armies that were threatening the Fatherland itself.

In this new history of this vital campaign, respected military historian Anthony Tucker-Jones describes the race against time as the Germans fought to stave off the inevitable. It was essential that the Germans held the west bank in order to protect the Rhine crossings at Cologne, Bonn, Koblenz and Remagen, but Hitler was intent on counter-attacking in the Ardennes in the winter of 1944 and this meant there was little left to bolster the defences of the Rhine.

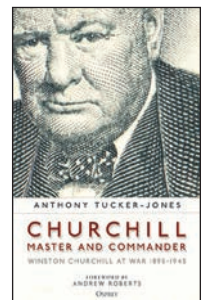
Rhineland relates the course of this fierce defence, describing the build-up of forces and operational plans before going on to tell the story of the campaign from the point of view of the forces involved, from the ordinary German soldier through to the high command.

Anthony Tucker-Jones, a former intelligence officer, is a highly prolific writer and military historian with well over 50 books to his name. His work has also been published in an array of magazines and online. He regularly appears on television and radio commenting on current and historical military matters.

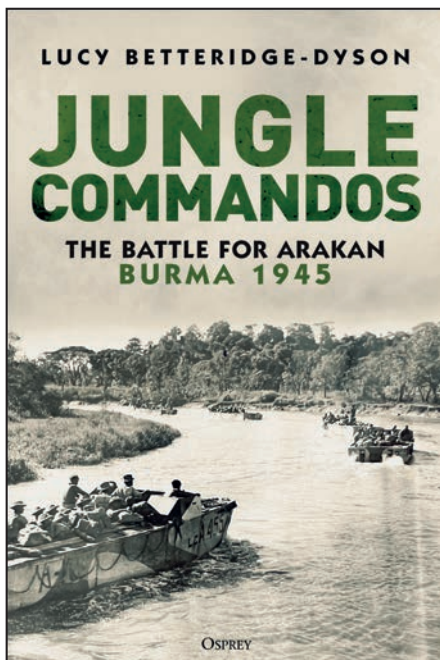

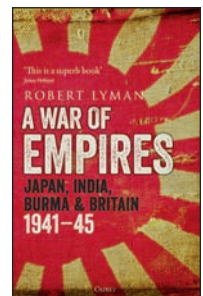
Drawing on unpublished first-hand accounts, this is a gripping history of the experiences of the Commandos and their unsung allies in one of the bloodiest battles of the Burma Campaign.

Following the battles of Kohima and Imphal in mid-1944, the tide was turning against the Imperial Japanese Army. By the end of that fateful year, the Allies were preparing to launch an offensive in the Arakan region of Burma, to deliver a knockout blow to the increasingly desperate Japanese 28th Army. This fascinating new history details the actions of 3 Commando Brigade, who would spearhead this attack in a series of daring amphibious landings into the depths of the Burmese jungle, culminating in the brutal fight for Hill 170.

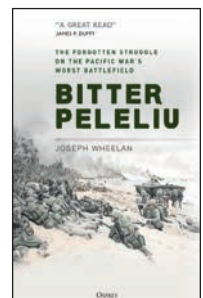
They would be the only Commando Brigade to serve in the Far East, yet their story has never before been told in detail. Drawing on previously unseen primary sources, this book is the story of the men who volunteered for a fight against a fearless enemy, 5000 miles away from home, in one of the most unforgiving environments in the world.

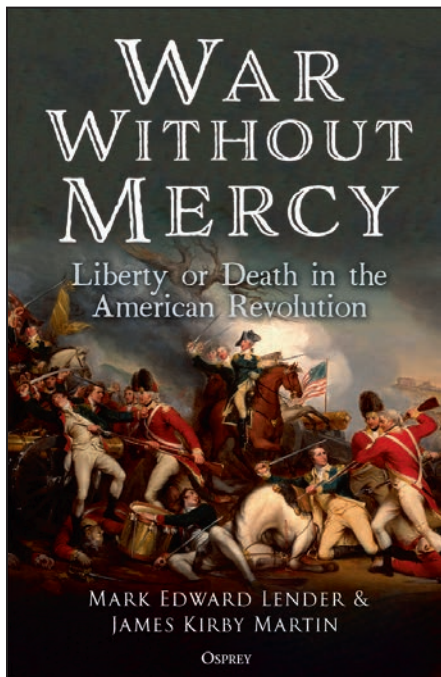

War Without Mercy

Liberty or Death in the American Revolution

Mark Edward Lender and James Kirby Martin

Drawing on vivid contemporary accounts, this is a fascinating exploration of how and why the Revolutionary War descended into a brutal existential struggle.

This engrossing history conclusively shows that those caught up in it believed they had nothing to lose by fighting without regard for the rules of so-called “civilized warfare.” The clarion call to arms “Liberty or Death” was far more than just rhetoric. At its grimmest level, it was a conflict in which military restraint was more the exception than the rule, a struggle in which combatants believed their very existence was in question. This led to an acceptance of violence against persons and property as preferable to a defeat equated with political, cultural, and even physical extinction. It was war with an expectation and acceptance of ferocity and brutality – anything to avoid defeat.

Written by two esteemed Revolutionary War historians, *War Without Mercy* looks in detail at why the conflict took such a violent a turn. Based on years of research and enlivened by little-known primary sources, this is an intriguing and fresh look at a period of history we thought we knew.

Mark Edward Lender is Professor Emeritus of History at Kean University. He is co-author with James Kirby Martin of *A Respectable Army: The Military Origins of the Republic, 1763–1783*, which was required reading at West Point.

The Rise and Fall of the British Army, 1975–2025

Ben Barry

A new study of a critical period in the history of the British Army.

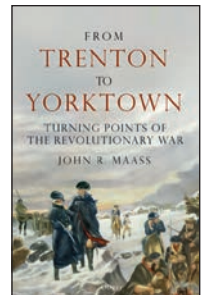
The last half century has seen society, technology, the character of conflict and the British Army itself all change greatly. From a low point in the 1970s, the Army’s war fighting capability increased in the 1980s in the face of a prospective war with the Soviet Union. This capability was then tested on operations from Kuwait in 1991 through to Afghanistan in 2001 and the 2003 invasion of Iraq.

There followed two decades of descent from this high plateau of military achievement. Mistakes made in Iraq and Afghanistan led to a decline in support for military deployments. Cuts to defence funding and botched equipment procurements also meant the British Army of 2021 was only half the size of that of 1970, and with much key fighting equipment either obsolete or approaching obsolescence.

Ben Barry served in the Army from 1975 to 2010, often in key staff appointments, and has worked closely with the Army in the following decade. This new study draws not only on his personal experience, but also on a very wide range of written sources complemented by interviews to provide a new interpretation of this period that challenges the existing narratives.

Previously serving in the British Army, Ben Barry is now Senior Fellow for Land Warfare in the International Institute for Strategic Studies and a visiting professor at the Department of War Studies, Kings College London.

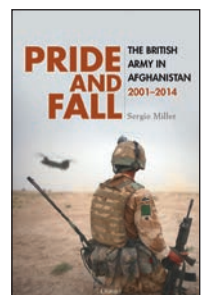

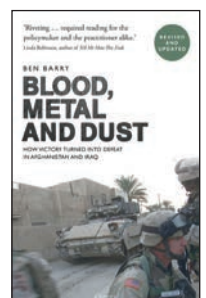

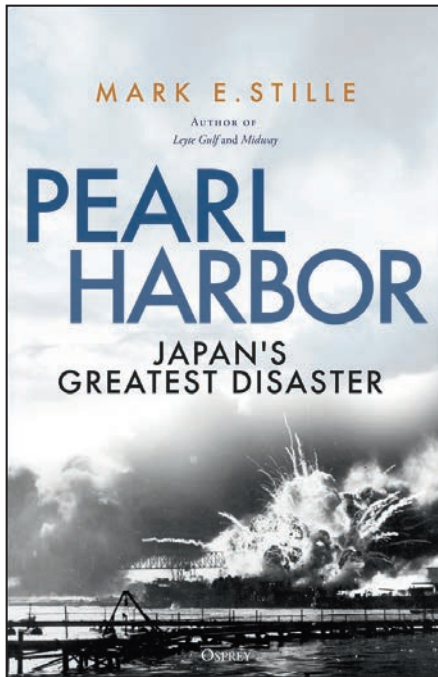

Mark E. Stille

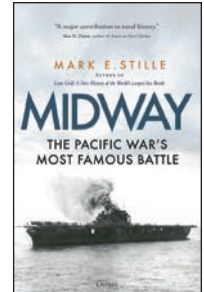
A detailed re-examination of the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor, the Day of Infamy that saw the USA enter World War II.

In this, the first comprehensive treatment of Pearl Harbor since the early 1990s, respected Pacific War naval historian Mark E. Stille traces the road to war and the Japanese attack itself. He examines the role of the man behind the operation, Japanese Admiral Yamamoto, as well as the strengths and weaknesses of the plan. The American preparations for an attack are also carefully reviewed. The heart of the book is a comprehensive narrative of Pearl Harbor along with an appreciation of its results placed in proper perspective.

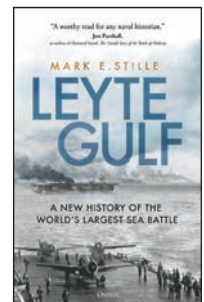
In common with many of the major campaigns of the Pacific War, a number of myths surround the Battle of Pearl Harbor, and, amongst others, this book explores and dismantles the myth of Yamamoto as a military genius, as well as the myth that the attack was brilliantly planned. Long regarded as a brilliant strike, *Pearl Harbor* puts forward the argument that the attack was instead a tactical disappointment, an operational failure and a strategic disaster.

Mark E. Stille is the author of numerous Osprey titles focusing on naval history in the Pacific. He recently concluded a nearly 40-year career in the intelligence community, including tours on the faculty of the Naval War College, on the Joint Staff and on US Navy ships. He received his BA in History from the University of Maryland and also holds an MA from the Naval War College.

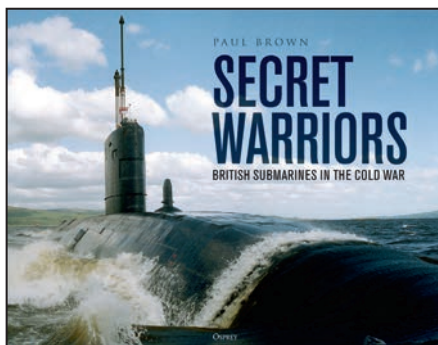

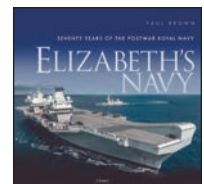
A highly illustrated history of the Cold War operations of the submarines of the Royal Navy from 1948 to 1990.

The Cold War was a period of intense activity for submarines of the Royal Navy, with many hair-raising incidents involving Soviet vessels. They were engaged in frequent hazardous surveillance patrols investigating Soviet submarines and surface warships and their operational tactics, and trailing Soviet strategic submarines, as well as conducting British deterrent SSBN patrols and protecting these using attack submarines (SSNs). There were also dangerous patrols which trialed submarine operation under the Arctic ice-cap. In addition to these activities there were operations in other conflicts and war theatres including the Falklands War, the Suez campaign, the Northern Ireland Troubles, and the Indonesian Confrontation.

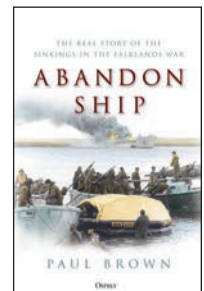

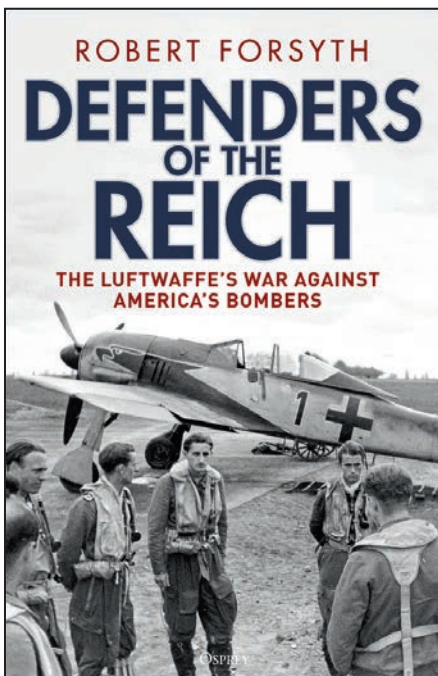

Defenders of the Reich

The Luftwaffe's War against America's Bombers

Robert Forsyth

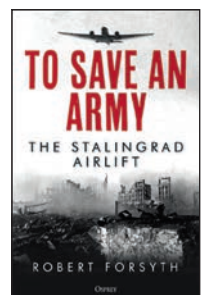
The story of the Luftwaffe fighter arm's desperate defence of the Third Reich from the growing Allied bomber offensive in World War II.

The *Reichsverteidigung* (Defence of the Reich) was a do-or-die campaign that saw the very best fighter pilots in the Luftwaffe attempt to defend German skies from increasingly large formations of RAF and USAAF medium and heavy bombers. Flying both piston-engined and, eventually, the first jet-engined fighters to see operational service, the *Jagdflieger* employed a wide range of weapons and tactics in an effort to blunt the Allied air offensive across Nazi Germany and Occupied Europe.

Defenders of the Reich focuses on the story of the pilot, his aircraft, his weaponry, his training, dangerous missions and Luftwaffe tactics against the USAAF and RAF bombers from the summer of 1942 through to VE Day. Leading Luftwaffe historian Robert Forsyth uses German and Allied archival documents, coupled with interviews with former *Jagdflieger* pilots, to tell the history of this last-ditch aerial campaign from the perspective of the Luftwaffe.

Robert Forsyth is an author, editor and publisher specializing in military aviation and military history. He is the author of more than 25 titles for Osprey Publishing on the aircraft, units and operations of the Luftwaffe, an interest he has held since boyhood. He has written articles for *The Aviation Historian*, *Aerjournal*, *Aeroplane Monthly*, *Aviation News*, *Combat Aircraft*, and *FlyPast* and he is a member of the Editorial Board of *The Aviation Historian*.
